

PSC-PACQUIAO AMATEUR BOXING CUP

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project will call for the nationwide development of the interest and participation in boxing as a sport. The ultimate goal is to tap promising boxers who will show potential during the competition. The project also aims to encourage these boxers to develop love for the sport during their formative years.

This PSC-PACQUIAO AMATEUR BOXING CUP is a weekend boxing tournament that will go around nationwide to scout potential amateur boxers that can be included in the pool of National boxers.

I.TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

The three major areas where this contest is to be conducted are Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.

I.A Mindanao

The competition for Mindanao region shall take place in six locations, i.e Kidapawan City, North Cotabato, Cagayan de Oro City, Davao City, Tagum City and 2 times in General Santos City (Preliminary and National Championship). The Preliminary for Mindanao leg shall take place in General Santos City, where the participating new talents from various parts of Mindanao shall compete on day 1 of the competition.

There will be a maximum of 16 entries per weight category for all divisions.

For the youth boys division, entries will be on five (5) weight categories, and four (4) for the girls division. For the junior boys and girls division, entries will be on five (5) weight classes.

Tournament days will be for a total of 6 weekends.

I.B Visayas

The competition for Visayas region shall take place in five locations, i.e. Ormoc City, Bago City, Antique, Bohol and Maasin City, where the participating new talents from various parts of Visayas shall participate in the competition.

There will be a maximum of 16 entries per weight category for all divisions.

For the youth boys division, entries will be on five (5) weight categories, and four (4) for the girls division. For the junior boys and girls division, entries will be on five (5) weight classes.

Tournament days will be for a total of 5 weekends.

I.C Luzon

The for Luzon region shall take place in five locations, i.e. Sorsogon, Lucena, Pangasinan, Baguio and Mandaluyong City, where the participating new talents from various parts of Luzon shall participate in the competition.

There will be a maximum of 16 entries per weight category for all divisions.

For the youth boys division, entries will be on five (5) weight categories, and four (4) for the girls division. For the junior boys and girls division, entries will be on five (5) weight classes.

Tournament days will be for a total of 5 weekends.

The same format shall be followed for the quarterfinals, semi-finals, and the finals wherein gold, silver and 2 bronze medalists will move to the National Championship.

The draw for the National championships of all medalists in the Area championship will be held right after the Luzon Area Championship.

Gold Medal winners of each Area Championships will be seeded automatically in the draw.

V.ELIGIBILITY OF BOXERS AND WEIGHT CATEGORIES

A. JUNIOR BOYS AND GIRLS DIVISION

AGE CLASSIFICATION - Boys and Girls between the ages of 15-16 years old will be eligible to compete. Cut-off date: 2001-2002.

WEIGHT CLASSIFICATION - Five (5) weight categories:

Pin	44-46 kg.
Light Fly	48 kg.
Fly	50 kg.
Light Bantam	52 kg.
Bantam	54 kg.

B. YOUTH BOYS AND GIRLS DIVISION

AGE CLASSIFICATION -Boys and Girls between the ages of 17-18 years old will be eligible to compete. Cut-off date: 1999- 2000.

WEIGHT CLASSIFICATION - **BOYS** - Five (5) weight categories:

GIRLS - Four (4) weight categories

- Junior Boys and Girls - 2 in a round and 3 for the whole duration of the bout
- Youth Boys - 3 in a round and 4 for the whole duration of the bout
- Youth Girls - 3 in a round and 4 for the whole duration of the bout

VIII.SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

A. UNIFORMS:

1. Boxers should bring two (2) sets of uniforms; complete red and blue sets not being mixed with any other color.
2. Boxers must wear a same color sets of either red or blue form fitting vest and shorts as per the boxer's respective corner allocation which will be their own responsibility.
3. The belt line of any shorts must be clearly indicated by a contrasting color and by using 6.10cm wide elastic waistband.
4. The length of the shorts must not be shorter than med-thigh, cannot cover the knee and must not worn above the belt line. The belt line is an imaginary line from the navel to the top of the hips and must not cover the navel.
5. Boxers shall box in light boots or shoes (w/o spikes or heels), socks not o be worn higher than the knee length.
6. Coaches/seconds must wear sports outfits. No slippers, sandals and other casual attires will be allowed.
7. Awardees must only wear their team uniform during the awarding ceremony. Slippers and sandals are not allowed.

B. All boxers (Boys and Girls) must bring the following items to the General Weigh-In:

1. An up to date Record/ Medical Book (RED BOOK) that has been properly filled-up with correct information and with 2x2 ID picture attached inside the page cover of the Book. ***(For those who do not have yet of the Red Book, PSC will provide for the boxer).***
2. Waiver of Liability
3. Parental Consent
4. Medical Certificate issued by a Medical Doctor

C. GIRL BOXERS

1. Girl boxers should have their parents or legal guardian signed their declaration of Non-Pregnancy
2. Hairnet or swimming cap is mandatory for long haired lady boxer. No Hairnet no boxing

(BOXERS WHO DO NOT COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SAID EVENT)

IX. BOXING EQUIPMENTS

A. GLOVES AND BANDAGES

The Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) will provide its licensed boxing gloves and bandages to all boxers. These will be distributed by the Equipment Manager. Boxers are not allowed to wear their personal gloves and head guards inside the ring. 10 oz. Gloves will be used.

Hand bandages will be provided by the PSC. Only a pair of hand of bandage will be given per boxer for the entire duration of the tournament

- B. HEADGUARDS:** PSC will provide its licensed boxing head guards to all boxers for all bouts
- C. CUP AND BREAST PROTECTORS** will also be available at the Equipment Manager's table if needed
- D. Boxers should bring their own Gum Shield.** No red or partially red colored gum shields may be worn

(Boxing gloves, cup and breast protectors and headguards are compulsory official items and are property of PSC, therefore, all equipment must be returned to the Equipment Manager after use)

X. REGULATIONS ON TEAM DELEGATIONS

A. Boxers

- Open to all amateur boxing clubs, organizations, teams and LGUs. However, only one

(1) team per LGU/Team is allowed to participate. Professional boxers and coaches are not allowed to participate.

(NO NATIONAL BOXERS in the PSC ROSTER may join the said tournament to give newcomers a chance to participate).

- Each team must submit their Entry Form and email them to PSC Support Services Office (supportservices@psc.gov.ph) with contact persons: Ms. Annie M. - **Only one (1) boxer can register per Weight Category.**

• It is permissible to substitute a boxer who fails to meet his/her Weight Category at the General Weigh-In. In that case, the Boxer may participate in a lower or higher Weight Category as long as there is no other boxer from that team who has already passed the official Weigh-In that weight category.

- All entries must be finalized before the General Weigh-In, in accordance with the AIBA Technical Rules and AOB competition Rules.

B. NUMBER OF TEAM OFFICIALS

- Each Team Delegation can have the following number of officials:
 - 1-4 boxers** - up to 2 coaches
 - 5-10 boxers** - up to 4 coaches
 - 11 or more boxers** - up to 6 coaches
- Each Team Delegation may be accompanied by one (1) Team Manager, one Team Doctor and one (1) Physiotherapist

C. REFEREE/JUDGE MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

Only invited and accredited referees and judges with **GOOD STANDING** and member of ABAP shall officiate in the tournament

XI. AWARDS

1. Medals – A gold medal will be awarded to the winner in each weight category, a silver medal for the runner-up.
2. All Bronze medalists will be awarded every after semi-final bouts.
3. Certificate of Appearance for all Boxers and Coaches
4. Certificate of Appreciation/Recognition for the Technical Officials
5. Other Awards

(MEDALISTS are qualified to compete in the National Championships but have to box in the same Weight Category where he/she won in the Area Tournaments. Boxers who do not comply will automatically be disqualified).

XII. MANAGEMENT GUIDELINES

The PSC-PACQUIAO AMATEUR BOXING CUP competition will be conducted with the following tournament schemes:

- a. There will be Qualifying Tournaments in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao
- b. There will be a National Championship

The Winners in all the Qualifying Tournaments in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao, (gold, silver and bronzes) will advance to the National Championship

- c. All Qualified boxers shall receive meal and transportation subsidy from the Philippine Sports Commission
- d. Medal counts will be credited to the respective LGU
