1. Pursuant to the General Administrative Support and Services Target of the Guidelines on the Grant of the Performance-Based Bonus for the Fiscal Year 2020 of the Administrative Order No. 25 Inter-Agency Task Force on the Harmonization of National Government Performance Monitoring, Information, and Reporting Systems Memorandum Circular No. 2020-1, and the Implementation of EPA issued under Government Procurement Policy Board Circular No. 06-2019, Heads of Procuring Entities shall submit to the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) a certification under oath on the compliance with Early Procurement Activities requirement within thirty (30) after the approval of the General Appropriations Act (GAA).
