C R I T E R I A F O R N O M I N A T I O N

a. Nominations may be made by any Filipino individual or organization.

a.1. Athletes

a.1.a. Amateur or Professional including the Differently-abled.

a.1.b. Retired from active international competition.

a.1.c. Gold Medalist in any Southeast Asian Games or at least a Silver Medalist in any Asian Games or Asian Cup or regional games or at least a Bronze medalist in any Olympic or World Games; or a titleholder or World Champion in any professional or amateur sports competition.

a.1.d. Athletic Performance should have a wide, historic and unprecedented global impact.

a.1.e. Candidates should have unquestionable integrity either local or abroad, before and after the event.

a.2. Coaches or Trainers

a.2.a. Amateur or Professional.

a.2.b. Retired from active coaching or training of international competitors.

a.2.c. Coached or trained a Gold medalist in any Southeast Asian Games or at least a Silver Medalist in any Asian Games or Asian Cup or regional games or at least a Bronze medalist in any Olympic or World Games; or a titleholder or World Champion in any professional or amateur sports competition.

a.2.d. Candidates should have unquestionable integrity either local or abroad, before and after the event.
